Laurie Goldsmith-Heitner ("Company" or "We") respect your privacy and are committed to protecting it through our compliance with this Online Privacy Statement ("Statement" or "OPS").

This Statement describes the types of information we may collect from you or that you may provide when you visit the website www.lghbenefits.com (Our "Website") and our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing that information. Any website domains that do not begin in www.lghbenefits.com are outside the scope of this Statement.

This Statement applies to information we collect:

- On this Website.
- In email, text, and other electronic messages.
- Through mobile and desktop applications you download from this Website, which provide dedicated nonbrowser-based interaction between you and this Website.

It does not apply to information collected by:

- Us offline or on any other website operated by Company or any third party; or
- Any third party, including through any application or content (including advertising) that may link to or be accessible from or on the Website.

If you do not agree with our policies and practices, your choice is not to use our Website. By accessing or using this Website, you agree to this Statement. Your continued use of this Website is deemed to be acceptance of any updates or changes made since you last visited the Website.

Our Website is not intended for children under 16 years of age. No one under age 16 may provide any information to or on the Website. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 16.

Information We Collect About You and How We Collect It

We collect several types of information from and about users of our Website, including information:

- By which you may be personally identified, such as name, postal address, e-mail address, telephone number, or any other information ("personal information");
- That is about you but individually does not identify you, and/or
- · About your internet connection, the equipment you use to access our Website, and usage details.

We collect this information:

- Directly from you when you provide it to us.
- Automatically as you navigate through the site. Information collected automatically may include usage details, IP addresses, and information collected through cookies, web beacons, and other tracking technologies.
- From third parties, for example, our business partners.

The information we collect on or through our Website may include:

- Information that you provide by filling in forms on our Website.
- Records and copies of your correspondence (including email addresses), if you contact us.

Should you choose to share your personal information with linked third-party websites, we cannot and do not guarantee that your information will not be viewed by unauthorized persons.

Information We Collect Through Automatic Data Collection Technologies

As you navigate through and interact with our Website, we may use automatic data collection technologies, i.e. Google Analytics and similar programs, to collect certain information about your equipment, browsing actions, and patterns, including:

- Details of your visits to our Website, including traffic data, location data, logs, and other communication data and the resources that you access and use on the Website.
- Information about your computer and internet connection, including your IP address, operating system, and browser type.

The information we collect automatically may include statistical data as well as personal information, and we may maintain it or associate it with personal information we collect in other ways or receive from third parties. The technologies we use for this automatic data collection may include:

- Cookies (or browser cookies). A cookie is a small file placed on the hard drive of your computer. You
 may refuse to accept browser cookies by activating the appropriate setting on your browser. However, if
 you select this setting you may be unable to access certain parts of our Website. Unless you have adjusted
 your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies when you direct your
 browser to our Website.
- Flash Cookies. Certain features of our Website may use local stored objects (or Flash cookies) to collect and store information about your preferences and navigation to, from, and on our Website. Flash cookies are not managed by the same browser settings as are used for browser cookies. For information about managing your privacy and security settings for Flash cookies.
- Web Beacons. Pages of our the Website [and our e-mails] may contain small electronic files known as web beacons (also referred to as clear gifs, pixel tags, and single-pixel gifs) that permit the Company, for example, to count users who have visited those pages or [opened an email] and for other related website statistics (for example, recording the popularity of certain website content and verifying system and server integrity).

We do not collect personal information automatically, but we may tie this information to personal information about you that we collect from other sources or you provide to us.

Third-Party Use of Cookies and Other Tracking Technologies

Some content or applications on the Website are served by third parties. These third parties may use cookies alone or in conjunction with web beacons or other tracking technologies to collect information about you when you use our website. The information they collect may be associated with your personal information or they may collect information, including personal information, about your online activities over time and across different websites and other online services. They may use this information to provide you with interest-based (behavioral) advertising or other targeted content.

We do not control these third parties' tracking technologies or how they may be used. How We Use Your Information

We use information that we collect about you or that you provide to us, including any personal information:

- To present our Website and its contents to you.

- In any other way we may describe when you provide the information.
- For any other purpose with your consent.

Disclosure of Your Information

We may disclose aggregated information about our users, and information that does not identify any individual, without restriction.

We may disclose personal information that we collect or you provide as described in this privacy Statement:

- To our subsidiaries and affiliates.
- To contractors, service providers, and other third parties we use to support our business and who are bound by contractual obligations to keep personal information confidential and use it only for the purposes for which we disclose it to them.
- To a buyer or successor in the event of a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, or dissolution.
- To fulfill the purpose for which you provide it.
- For any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information.

We may also disclose your personal information:

- To comply with any court order, law, or legal process.
- To enforce or apply our terms of use www.lghbenefits.com and other agreements.
- If we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of Laurie Goldsmith-Heitner, our customers, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organizations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.
